

ORDINANCE 414 - 2010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY COLONY BEACH, FLORIDA; AMENDING CHAPTER TWELVE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED PARKS AND RECREATION; SECTION 12-9. LIMITATIONS ON USE OF CERTAIN CITY PARK PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; REPEALING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to provide parks for use by the residents and visitors of the City of Key Colony Beach; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission encourages use of the parks for recreational activities in a safe manner; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission recognizes that parks not equipped with lighting may pose a safety risk to residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to provide for the health and safety of citizens and visitors by setting limits on the hours parks may be used.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY COLONY BEACH, FLORIDA, as follows: (Additions to the ordinance are underlined; deletions are ~~crossed-out~~.)

CHAPTER 12. PARKS AND RECREATION

Section 12-9. Limitations on use of certain city park property.

Use of the park property of the City of Key Colony Beach as described in section 12-1 shall be limited to the time from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. each day unless otherwise posted. Persons on the subject property during the prohibited hours shall be subject to penalties as set forth in section 1-9 of the Key Colony Beach Code.

This Ordinance, upon final passage, shall be included in the Code of Ordinances for the City of Key Colony Beach, Florida, and numbered as set forth herein above.

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

If any singular provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by federal or state law, or otherwise held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the Ordinance shall not be invalidated.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
